(1) Masters Degree in Zoology/ Physics/Applied Physics/ Mathematics/Computer Science/ Botany/ Anthropology/ Microbiology/Chemistry/Forensic Science/Psychology from a recognized University/institute.

(II) 10 years experience of crime-scene examination/ analytical methods/ research in the field of forensic science from Central/State Govts/UTs/Public Sector Undertakings/Semi-Govt./Autonomous Organizations/ Govt recognized Universities/ Institutions.

Desirable:

Doctorate degree in concerned discipline from a recognized University

Note 2: The departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on promotion.

Note 3: The period of deputation including short-term contract (ISTC) in another ex- cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization/Department of the Central Government shall
